

LEARNING ABOUT PORTABLE GENERATOR SAFETY

Spot the mistakes

Below are some examples of portable generators being used improperly. See if you can spot the mistakes in each example and list them below.













Mistakes:

- A. The portable generator is being used in the garage. Generators should only be operated outside.
- B. The generator is about to be filled while running. Always turn off generators and let cool before refueling.
- C. The generator's fumes are pointing towards the picnic area. Always point fumes away from houses and people.
- D. The generator is much too close to the RV and tent. The generator should be moved as far away as possible.
- E. The generator is much to close to the house and near the window. Always keep generators away from windows.
- F. The generator is being plugged into a normal wall socket. Never plug a generatot into a normal wall socket.
